






She teaches English at a secondary school in Badalona. She also works as a project coordinator. Badalona is a Spanish city close to Barcelona.



Boys and girls do not sit together. Boys sit on the left side and girls on the right side.





Children speak and write Arabic. They write from left to right.

My London report


I am Samantha and I will present London. We visited many places.


There is a shop where you can customize a clay bear. You choose the colors you want, pour them into a bowl and then pour it over the bear. It takes a long time to dry but it's worth it.

INGREDIENTS (for 12 muffins)

2 bananas

I egg

II5g butter

80 ml milk

I20g sugar

230g flour

I,5 teaspoon baking powder pinch of salt I20g chopped chocolate

PROCEDURE

- I.) Heat the oven to 180°C.
- 2.) Take a bowl and melt butter.
- 3.) Mix flour, baking powder and salt.
- 4.) Peel the banana and squish it in a bowl.
- 5.) Add egg, melted butter, sugar and milk.
 - 5.) Add the dry ingredients.
 - 6.) Mix well.
 - 7.) Add the chopped chocolate.
- 7.) Put the mixture inside the paper models.
 - 8.) Bake for 20 -25 min.
